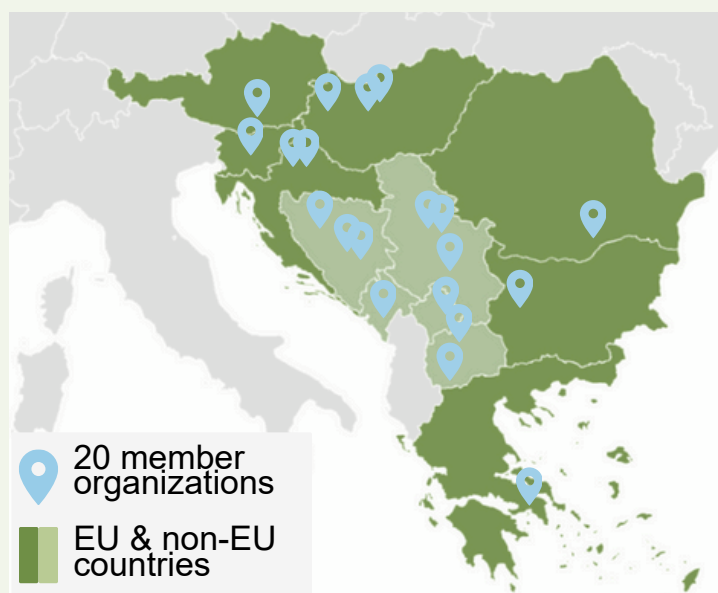
## WHAT WE DO

## SEASN NETWORK



SEASN operates across Southeast Europe and the Western Balkans, bringing together 20 member organisations from both EU and non-EU countries. The network covers Slovenia, Croatia, Hungary, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Serbia, Montenegro, North Macedonia, Kosovo, Greece, Bulgaria, and Romania, as well as parts of Austria (Carinthia), fostering regional cooperation and knowledge exchange across diverse contexts.
